Emine Serdaroğlu began her piano studies with Prof. Ersin Onay, continued with Fuat Türkay and Prof. Cana Gürmen, and obtained her Bachelor of Music degree at Illinois Wesleyan University with high honors following her studies with Prof. Dr. Mark Hansen. She completed her Master of Music degree at the University of Texas, Austin with Prof. Dr. William Race and received her PhD in Musicology at Mimar Sinan Fine Arts University. She became an Associate Professor in 2011. Serdaroğlu has had the opportunity to work with pianists including Andrey Diev, Rita Sloan, Lala Margulis, Igor Kipnis and Ratko Delorko, and has given recitals in Turkey, the USA, Germany and Sweden. With Dilbağ Tokay, as CelloPianoDuo, she has given acclaimed performances in Sweden, Bulgaria, Austria, Germany, Belgium, Serbia, Cyprus, France, Italy, India, Brazil, Romania, Georgia and Turkey. Their "Turkish Music for Cello and Piano" CD was released by NAXOS and received "2016 Recording of the Year Award" at the prestigious Donizetti Classical Music Awards. "Violoncello and Piano Works" was released by Pür Records in 2023. Both of these albums are available on various digital platforms including Spotify and Apple Music. Emine Serdaroğlu also frequently collaborates with renown musicians in a wide variety of musical projects. Her concerts were recorded by various radio and TV stations including TRT (Turkish National Radio and Television). She gave interviews at various national and international TV programs. She teaches full time at Boğazici University Fine Arts Department, gives masterclasses and actively participates in conferences with her research on piano works of Turkish composers, piano pedagogy and music education.
